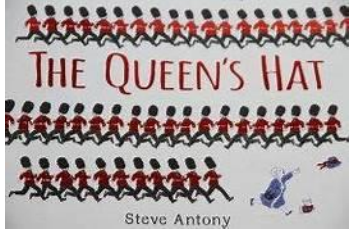


Year 1 Curriculum Map – Autumn Term 2



Literacy

This term we will be reading *The Queen's Hat* by Steve Anthony. The children will continue to work on their literacy skills of

- Predicting
- Write sentences using simple sentence structures.
- Use the joining word 'and' to extend sentences.

- Write sentences to create simple narratives.

Maths

In maths the children will continue to follow Maths Mastery to develop their mathematical skills. This term the children will be learning:

Numbers to 20

- Identify, represent, compare and order numbers to 20
- Doubling and halving
- One more and one less

Addition and subtraction within 20

Represent and explain addition and subtraction strategies including 'Make Ten'

- Use known facts to add and subtract

Science – Everyday Materials; What are Toys Made From and Seasons; Autumn

- To find out what the weather is like in Autumn.
- To take part in a practical investigation at the Soanes Centre.
- To identify and name a variety of everyday materials used to make toys.
- To explore and describe wooden toys and their properties.
- To explore and describe plastic toys and their properties.
- To explore and describe fabric toys and their properties
