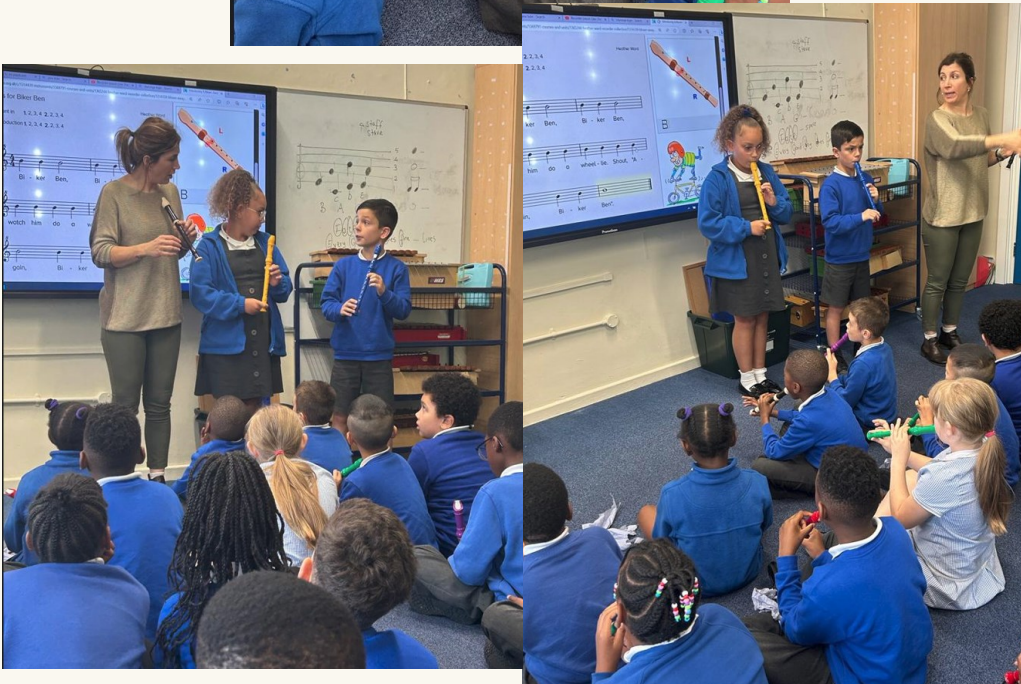




Year 3 & Year 4

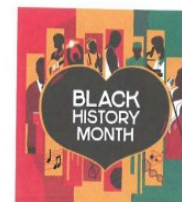
Black History Month colours represents a meaning.

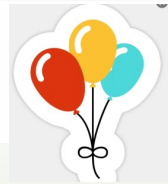

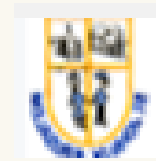
