# 1. Quality of Education

#### Curriculum

- More fully understand how the school is demonstrating its intent, implementation and impact of the curriculum across all subjects
- Challenge and support the school as it implements the new curriculum model for the foundation subjects and monitor impact
- Ensure that the systems and support are in place to allow all pupils to satisfactorily access the curriculum

### **Teaching**

- Governors to work closely with their Link teachers to better understand the effectiveness of subject delivery in the classroom
- Monitor improvements and outcomes for SEND pupils and other pupils who struggle with their learning
- Challenge and support the school as it works to secure higher quality and more outstanding teaching

### 2. Behaviour and Attitudes

- Governors to undertake Learning Walks so that they can see for themselves the behaviour and conduct of pupils throughout the school
- Encouraging a culture that promotes positive mental wellbeing for all members of staff so that adults can be positive role models for the pupils

# 3. Personal Development

- Whilst focusing on financial sustainability, ensure that the personal development of all pupils remains a top priority when making decisions about expenditure
- Challenge the school to think creatively when working on strategies to support the pupils' personal development

# 4. Leadership and Management

 Provide challenge and support to the school whilst it strives for continual improvement

- Monitor that changes of role and personnel amongst the senior members of staff in the school are effective and best serve the drive for school improvement
- Encourage and support governors as they take on new or additional roles within the Governing Body (e.g. new Committee Chairs, Links, etc.) as part of active succession plans
- Continue to champion and monitor the wellbeing of all members of the school community
- The Resources Committee will continue to be rigorous in setting an appropriate budget and closely monitoring expenditure throughout the year so that early action can be taken if revenue shortfalls are identified

- Encourage the school to develop and maintain effective communication with parents and carers
- Support the school in maintaining and developing its distinctive Christian character
- Support and encourage the school to address the challenge of a falling roll and thereby secure a sustainable future
